





#### **Test Flow Chart of XRF**



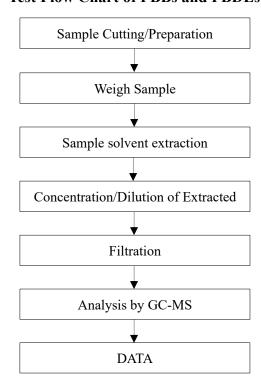
#### **Test Flow Chart of Phthalates**








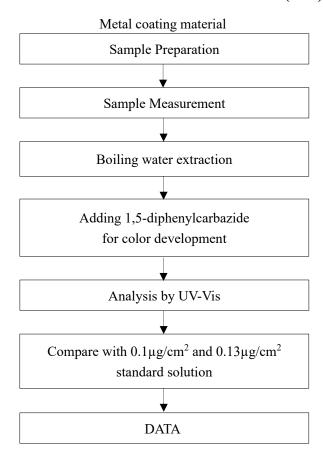
### **Test Flow Chart of PBBs and PBDEs**









# Test Flow Chart of Hexavalent Chromium (Cr6+)
